THE JULY 28 FEMA REGISTRATION DEADLINE PASSED.

WHAT HAPPENS NOW?

If you've already applied, its not too late to appeal!

You have 60 days from the date that FEMA makes a decision to appeal that decision - if you already registered & already have a FEMA registration number, **the July 28 deadline does not affect you!**

You can still register late*



FEMA accepts late registrations for 60 days after the deadline. Late registrations must be submitted by **September 26, 2023**. If you register late, you must write a letter explaining why you were late and provide supporting documents showing "good cause" for late registration.



*44 CFR § 206.112(c) authorizes a 60 day late registration period

Examples of good cause for late registration:

Hospitalization, illness, disability, death in the family, travel off-island during the whole application period, or other unique circumstances related to the disaster.
