Micronesian Legal Services Corporation (MLSC) seeks to increase access to justice throughout Micronesia, through a network of regional offices in the Marshall Islands, the Federated States of Micronesia, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, the Republic of Palau, and Guam.

MLSC is seeking applications for the position of **Attorney** in our office on Guam, which is located on the 9th Floor of the DNA Building in Hagatña. This is a full time temporary position for one to two years.

Qualifications:

- Have graduated from an ABA-accredited law school; or be admitted to practice before
 the highest court of a jurisdiction where that court's jurisprudence is based upon the
 common law tradition; and
- Admitted to practice before the courts of Guam, or eligible to be admitted.

General Responsibilities:

Handle a wide variety of civil cases, including both litigated and non-litigated matters; conduct community outreach and education; and actively collaborate with others to increase access to justice for low-income residents of Guam; work as a member of our Disaster Response Team to provide legal help in support of survivors of Typhoon Mawar.

Compensation and Benefits:

Compensation from \$51,350 to \$90,000 per year, depending on experience, and generous benefits including retirement, health insurance, and leave.
